WHAT ARE ELECTRONIC INFORMATION RESOURCES?


Electronic Information Resources

The databases may be used **by students and staff** exclusively **for** their **study and research purposes**.

Electronic Information Resources.



HOW ARE THEY DIVIDED?

By discipline/alphabetically

- licensed
 - accessible only from the IP address of university
 - · login via remote access required
- freely available
 - offers high quality freely available resources
 - also available outside the University IP address

If remote access is functional, when you click on the licensed database, it will show you a login form where you enter your email in the form: ...@upjs.sk

and the **password** you created for the
wifi and the proxy server.

TRIAL ACCESS

-- can only be used **for a limited time.**For these, it is also **necessary to have remote access setup.**

SCIENTOMETRIC DATABASES

- -- located within licensed databases
- focus on scientific publications and use the results of analyses of journals, publications and citations to **evaluate science.**

SUMMON

- is **central search engine** that allows us to search **in one place** in all **licensed resources** available at the University Library.
